#### Shape before the rule is proposed

- Grassroots Email Campaign
  - 5,775 were submitted
- $\circ\,$  Political pressure from Hill Democratic influencers to the Administration
  - Tester Letter
  - Pence/Golden Letter (22 Signers)
- $_{\odot}$  Advocates letter that supports the mandate
  - Doggett/Schakowsky Letter (115 Signers)





#### What Are We Trying to Shape?

- 1. Must be fully funded
- 2. Cannot go into effect until our workforce has been rebuilt
- 3. There must be a broad definition of worker
- 4. There must be a reasonable waiver
- 5. It must be demonstrated and then phased in


- Another grassroots formal comment campaign


#### LONG TERM CARE: WORST IMPACTED THAN ANY OTHER HEALTH CARE SECTOR






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#### Percent Change in Health Care Sector Employment since February 2020



#### Market Basket Update Driven by Forecast Error

Market Basket and Adjustments	Figures
Unadjusted Market Basket	2.7%
Forecast Error	3.6%
Subtotal	6.3%
Parity Adjustment	(2.3%)
Total Factor Productivity Adjustment	(0.2%)
Proposed Net Market Basket	3.7%

Notes:

- Numbers do not add precisely due to rounding
- Market Basket update in final rule likely will differ CMS uses updated data for the Final Rule
- Provider specific updates will vary based on wage index, and labor adjustments
