- **Performing rescue breathing:** The skills and knowledge acquired in CPR are applicable in different areas of life. CPR training offers capabilities on rescue breathing to bring back victims who have stopped breathing in cases of severe asthma attacks, choking and more.
 - **Emergencies can occur anywhere when least expected:** According to the American Heart Association research findings, close to 200,000 lives could be saved annually with effective CPR. When a cardiac arrest emergency occurs away from the hospital, the victim's survival depends on the people around to give the necessary assistance.
